### It's costing you to landfill!

Businesses in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough send around 1 million tonnes of waste to landfill every year! Each year this becomes more expensive as landfill tax continues to rise.

By recycling as much of their waste as possible businesses can typically save 1% of turnover, or about £1,000 per employee.

# Reduce

### Business Link

Business Link has produced a guide on how you can save money by reducing waste.

# Recycle

### Local Authority Services

Your local authority may offer both advice and provide a business waste recycling collection service that would suit your needs. Contact your local authority for more information on the services they offer (contact details are provided on the back page of this leaflet).

### Waste Recycling Directory

A national directory, developed by WRAP (Waste & Resources Action Program), lists licensed waste recycling companies that accept or collect a wide variety of wastes.

Users can search the directory by postcode and by waste type to find local recycling services that suit their needs.

The recycling directory is free to use and no registration is required.
